BIG WINNERS ON "HAPPENING '68"

The Heart Beats have appeared twice on nation-wide television where they placed first on "Happening '68" winning \$10,000 in prizes and a record contract with A.B.C. Records.

Debbie McMillan plays bass and does group singing.
