
Dear Attorney Introcaso,

The Court appointed me to represent Ms. Katz on docket #08-S-2403. The indictment has since been dismissed. The state continues to file new charges as the earlier ones are dismissed. The successive charges contain essentially the same allegations, but the docket number I was appointed to has now been dismissed.

There are two remaining indictments [09-S-2521 & 2522] and one remaining information [10-S-459]. I have continued working on these cases as it is my understanding that the Court intends to appoint me to these cases as well. Ms. Katz requires substantially more time and effort than most clients and recent interactions with the Judicial Council have left me regretting any willingness to be flexible in such matters with time intensive clients.




